### Change in Schedule for Last Day of School

In an effort to bring staff together, District 34 has modified the schedule for the last day of school for most students. The following is a summary of information related to that modified schedule:

The last day of school for kindergarten students will be June 4th.

**The last day of school for students in Grades 1-7 will be June 5th. However, there will be a shortened schedule for that day. The schedule is as follows:**

**7:55-11 (Intermediate Schedule)**

**8:25-11:30 (Middle School Schedule)**

**8:55-12 (Primary Schedule)**

**The last day for eighth grade students remains as May 30th.**

Transportation will be provided to all students who typically ride the bus, just as with a normal scheduled school day.
