IMPORTANT: 4:05pm Pick up Safety Procedure

In the spring we have an increase in the number of students staying after school for activities. Therefore, there will be more students taking the late activity buses as well as parents waiting to pick up their students. This is causing congestion at the Washington Street parking lot.

Cars are not permitted to:

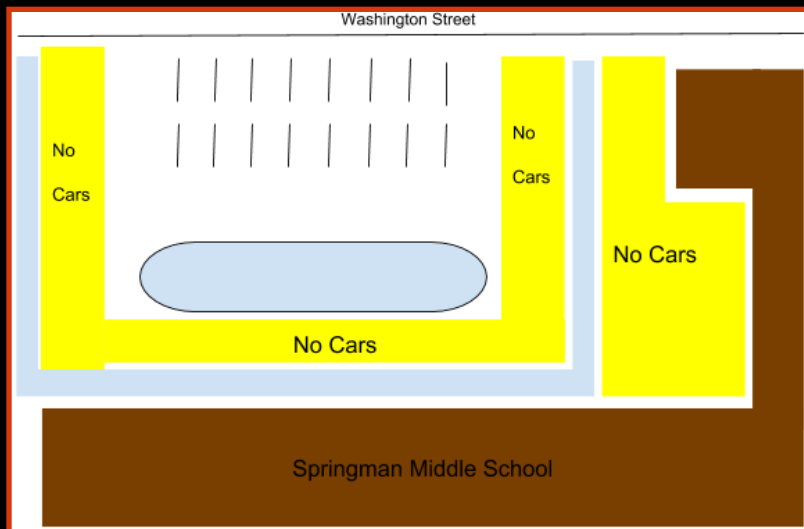
- Block the late buses from entering the parking lot
- Enter the bus loop which is the lane closest to the school
- Enter the access road on the north side of the sidewalk

It is important that the buses are able to enter the bus loop so they are prepared to pick up students when the 4:05 bell rings. In addition, students exit through the B door near the LRTC; therefore, cars should not be on the access road.

Cars should park in a parking space and proceed with care when exiting the lot.

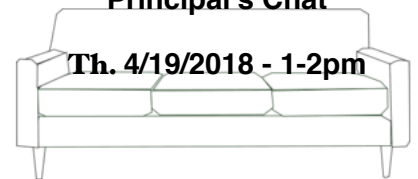

PHYSICALS - PLEASE REMEMBER:

All incoming 6th grade students **MUST** have a current physical on file in order to start the 2018-19 school year. Your child **CANNOT** attend class until we receive a valid physical (along with immunization record) given *within one year of the starting date of school* or a written note from your child's doctor indicating the date when they will have a well child exam.

The following information was recently provided by the Illinois State Board of Education regarding the upcoming Illinois Science Assessment. All 5th and 8th graders will take the Illinois Science Assessment (ISA). The ISA aligns with the Illinois Learning Standards for science. The ISA represents Illinois' commitment to preparing all students for college and careers, including in the high-demand science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields. The assessment also satisfies federal accountability requirements.
