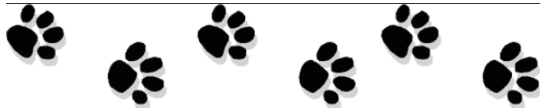

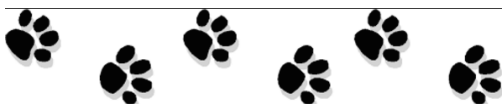
Activity Buses: How To

All students, even if they don't take a regular bus, have access to early and late bus routes. Students should check their ID for their early and late activity bus route "letter". If no "letter" appears, students should see Mrs. Ford in the office.

Early Activity Bus Route information was sent home in the before school mailing. Students simply need to stand along their route and wave at the driver to be picked up.

Students choosing to stay after school for a sponsored activity (clubs, intramurals, etc.), to meet with a teacher, or to use the LRTC, may utilize the 4:10pm Activity Buses. Only students who participate in these activities will be issued a Late Bus Pass by the adult who supervised them during the activity period. Students staying after school must be in a supervised activity with a staff member.

There are fewer buses for the 4:10pm Activity Bus Run than for the regular afternoon bus Run so students will have a longer walk from the bus stops to their residences.
